

GRAND LAKES MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 2
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District (the "Board") will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being an official meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on *Monday, April 15, 2024, at 11:00 a.m.*

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting held on March 18, 2024;
3. Review and discussion of the monthly activity reports prepared by the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office and Fort Bend County Precinct 1 Constable's Office;
4. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports; authorize the payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
6. Review of Delinquent Tax Collection Attorneys' Report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P.; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
7. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes and authorize the delinquent tax attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent real property taxes beginning July 1, 2024, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
8. Sales Tax Revenue Status Report;
9. Operation and Maintenance Report, including:
 - A. Monthly report;
 - B. Appeals of District charges and other customer billing matters;
 - C. Repair and maintenance of District facilities, including consideration of any contracts for same and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission Form 1295 ("TEC Form 1295");
 - D. Refer accounts for collection;
 - E. Approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - F. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same; and
 - G. Reclaimed water system and irrigation;

11. Authorize operator to prepare draft Consumer Confidence Report for review by Board of Directors;
12. Operator's annual report regarding status of the District's Identity Theft Prevention Program (the "Program"), including discussion of Program compliance, staff training, effectiveness and suggested changes;
13. Status of preparation of Annual Implementation Report regarding Water Conservation Plan and the filing of same with the North Fort Bend Water Authority (due May 1, 2024);
14. Status of review of Water Conservation Plan and adoption of amendments as appropriate, including the adoption of a Resolution regarding review of said plan; authorize filing of amended plan with regulatory agencies;
15. Status of review of Drought Contingency Plan and adoption of amendments as appropriate, including the adoption of a Resolution regarding review of said plan, consider comments and input from the public, authorize publication of notice, as required;
16. Engineer's Report, including:
 - A. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans;
 - B. Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith, including wastewater treatment plant site permit;
 - C. Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
 - D. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same, including:
 - E. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes; and
 - F. Review and approval of amended Capital Improvement Plan;
17. Issuance of utility commitments and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same;
18. Discussion regarding the status of the proposed development of Jason's Deli by Grand Parkway Shopping Center, Ltd.;
