NOTICE OF SPECIAL PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District (the "Board") will hold a special public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being an official meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Monday, February 2, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board meeting held on December 15, 2025;
3. Review and discussion of law enforcement services within the District, including the monthly activity report prepared by Fort Bend County Precinct 1 Constable's Office;
4. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
5. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports; authorize the payment of invoices presented;
6. Status of Municipal Information Services Rate Analysis Report;
7. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
8. Review of Delinquent Tax Collection Attorneys' Report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P.; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
9. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2026, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
10. Discussion of exemptions from taxation for 2026, and adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
11. Sales Tax Revenue Status Report;
12. Operation and Maintenance Report, including:
 - A. Monthly report;
 - B. Appeals of District charges and other customer billing matters;
 - C. Repair and maintenance of District facilities, including consideration of any contracts for same and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;

- D. Refer accounts for collection;
 - E. Approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - F. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
 - G. Reclaimed water system and irrigation;
 - H. Discussion of the annual maintenance and painting of District facilities; and
 - I. Review rate analysis and take any necessary action related thereto;
13. Consider Rate Order Amendment;
14. Authorize operator to provide required information in connection with the annual Consumer Confidence Report to districts that received water from the District during the previous calendar year and prepare a draft Consumer Confidence Report for review by Board of Directors;
15. Approval of:
- A. Amendments to the Waste Disposal Agreement and the Water Plant Agreements between the District and Grand Lakes Municipal Utility District No. 4; and
 - B. Interlocal Agreement for Repair of Facilities (Peek and Fry Roads Repairs);
16. Engineer's Report, including:
- A. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans;
 - B. Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith, including wastewater treatment plant site permit;
 - C. Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, including:
 - i. Consideration of Lift Station Improvements proposal;
 - D. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295 related to same, including:
 - i. Status of construction of Water Line Improvements to Serve Jason's Deli by Grand Parkway Shopping Center (GM Vera Construction);
 - E. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - F. Review and approval of Capital Improvement Plan; and
 - G. Discussion of the Status of the SH 99 Northbound Frontage Road Improvement Project and status of possible water line relocation;
17. Discussion regarding status of Lazy River Pool Rehabilitation Project, including matters related to contract with Petra Construction, LLC;
18. Review of annual survey of wage rate scales and consider adoption of Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Projects;
19. Adoption of Resolution Concerning Developed District Status for 2026 Tax Year;

20. Status of Engineer's Report in connection with planned bond authorization election and discussion of other related bond authorization election matters, including the engagement of Touchstone District Services , LLC for election marketing services;

26. Matters related to Directors Election to be called for May 2, 2026, including: (i) memorandum regarding joint elections, and (ii) notification of Fort Bend County officials that the District intends to participate in the joint election;

 - B. calling Bond Authorization Election;
28. Convene Closed Session for consultation with attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, as amended;
29. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any actions related to matters discussed in Closed Session;
30. Attorney's Report;
31. Take action on matters discussed during Closed Session; and
32. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
